The Farming and Wildlife Advisory Group (FWAG SW) are working with farmers, land-owners and communities to slow the flow of surface water and small streams using Natural Flood Management techniques.

This aims to reduce flood risk, reduce erosion, improve water quality and to deliver wider environmental benefits.

Advice and grants are available for:

- Land management agreements
- Soil management
- In channel features e.g. leaky dams, woody flow spreaders, gabions
- Water attenuation features e.g. ponds, scrapes, bunds, silt traps, and floodplain storage
- In-field features e.g. filter fences, coir rolls
- Woodland and hedge planting
- Infrastructure e.g. cross drains
